ROWE-WEATHERFORD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

This program provides qualified scholarships as defined in IRS Publication 520 and may be used as such by the student for tuition and fees paid to enroll in or to attend an educational institution, and/or for fees, books, supplies, and equipment that are required for the courses at the educational institution. These items (fees, books, supplies and equipment) must be required of all students in the same course of instructions. Funds cannot be used for room and board, transportation or any other items that would make the funds taxable income under IRS guidelines.

Applicants must have a parent, grandparent (including step relation), or legal guardian which is a member of the FBINAA Arkansas Chapter or be the child of any Arkansas Law Enforcement Officer who was killed in the line of duty.

Selected applicants will receive a \$1000.00 scholarship per scholastic year. Applicants must apply each year and can only receive a total of four (4) scholarship awards. Total number of scholarships issued each year is dependent upon available funds.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION BOARD:

This Board will consist of four (4) members, two (2) current board members, and two (2) members from the general membership appointed by the Chapter President. Scholarship Selection Board members cannot be related to a scholarship applicant.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Deadline for applications to be received by the Chapter Second Vice President is **APRIL 30, 2025**.

Awarding of scholarships will be posted on our Chapter website by the first week of **May 2025**.

All questions must be answered. If a question does not apply, indicate N/A.

If additional space is required, attach extra pages.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

In order to qualify an applicant must have a parent, grandparent (including step relation), or legal guardian which is a member of the FBINAA Arkansas Chapter or be the child of any Arkansas Law Enforcement Officer who was killed in the line of duty.

Applicant must currently have an overall GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

Applicants must have scored at least a 19+ on the ACT.

Applicants must submit a completed application form.

Must submit an official high school or college transcript of current grades which includes the GPA.*

Applicants who are incoming freshman, must submit a qualifying ACT transcript report.*

College students must be taking a minimum of **24** college hours per school year.

The Scholarship Selection Board reserves the right to conduct interviews, request documents or make other requests necessary to fulfill the selection process.

Awardees will be required to provide a copy of their final transcript, via the scholarship email address prior to being given their scholarship payment.

***A downloaded version from the Internet is not acceptable.**

RENEWAL:

To renew/continue a scholarship, a completed application and an official transcript of grades must be submitted by **APRIL 30th** of each year.
